





COVID-19 UPDATES

After talking with our Parliamentarian, Rev. Paul Crowley, he and I agreed that the situation we are all dealing with now justifies certain actions by our Executive Team (which is designated as the Emergency Operations Team for the GCBA). On Thursday April 2, 2020 the Executive Team met by video conference and took the following actions:

They voted in this meeting to CANCEL both the April Executive Board meeting and the Spring Associational meeting. (The Team initially had postponed the April Executive Board and Springs Associational meetings until May.)

There were two items of business which needed to be considered at those meetings:

approval of the Nominating Committee report; and, action on the petition of

Empowerment Ministries Christian Center to become part of the GCBA, having

completed one year of Watch-care status. Acting on behalf of the Association, the Nominating Committee report was approved. The petition of Empowerment

Ministries Christian Center was also approved.

They also ratified an action taken by the Finance Team that allows for only one signature on checks written during the "shelter-at-home" restrictions resulting from COVID-19. Our Financial Policies call for checks to be signed by two signers. Allowing for only one signature will expedite getting bills paid for which we write checks. This is a temporary allowance.

These actions will be presented for ratification the next time we are able to meet with the Executive Board (hopefully in our July meeting) or by the Association in session.
